- Found misspellings, weak dates
- Living in Springfield. Wm was born in Ohio, Ellen was born in **Ireland**

**I got lucky in finding William McNeal and wife Ellen Glynn**

- Name: William W. McNeal, born Madison County, Ohio, 26 Jan 1874
- Wife: not cited died before 1939
- He died: Springfield, Clark County, Ohio, 3 May 1939
- Father: **John McNeal**, born West Jefferson, **Ohio** (Not so)
- Mother: **Dorothy Ellen McNeal**, born in **Ireland**
- Informant: Miss Edna McNeal (likely his child)
- Wm Buried in Calvary Cemetery Clark County, Ohio

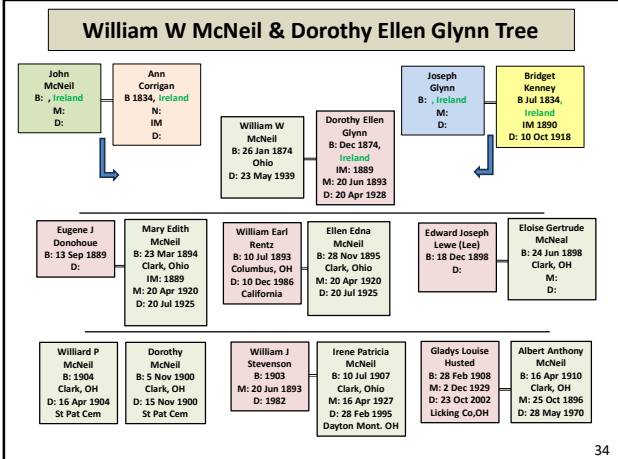

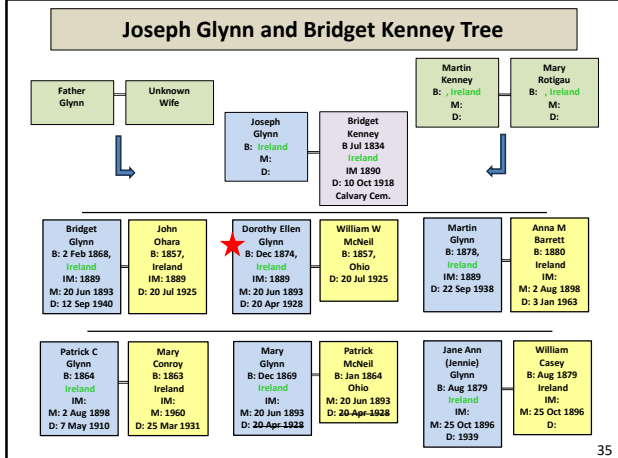
